With these policies in place, we believe that we can achieve a healthy and safe environment. We are committed to and will:

- Provide a safe and healthful workplace and ensure that personnel are properly trained with the appropriate safety and emergency equipment
- Be an environmentally responsible neighbor in the community where we operate, and correct incidents or conditions that endanger health, safety, or the environment. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Treating our drinking water at our facility and minimizing ground water use whenever possible
 - Managing our facility's wastewater in a responsible manner
 - Minimizing our carbon footprint by subsidizing the use of public transport and carpooling with our employees
- Develop and improve operations and technologies to minimize waste and other pollution, encourage recycling, minimize health and safety risks, and dispose of waste safely and responsibly.
- Ensure the responsible use of energy throughout our business, including conserving energy, improving energy efficiency, and giving preference to renewable over non-renewable energy sources where feasible. MFK is embarking on a solar power program that will allow us to produce much of the needed facility power from solar energy, thereby reducing emissions
- Incorporate soil erosion techniques, water conservation and aflatoxin training in our agriculture farmer training programs to ensure a healthy future for Haiti and its agricultural communities
